The Law Office Climate Challenge was formed by the ABA Section of Environment, Energy and Resources (SEER), in cooperation with the EPA. This program is designed to encourage law offices to take specific steps to conserve energy and resources, as well as reduce emissions of greenhouse gases. Enrolling in the challenge required the firm to adopt policies related to resource and energy conservation, including purchasing paper products with at least 30% recycled content, recycling discarded office paper, and implementing double-sided copying and printing for drafts and internal documents.

In addition, the firm has formed the Snell & Wilmer Green Committee to promote environmentally sustainable practices.
