Gregory A. Brower Receives Patriot Award For Exceptional Support of National Guard and Reserve Employees

It is the lead DoD organization for this mission under DoD Directive 1250.1. Today, ESGR operates through a network of thousands of volunteers throughout the nation and Guam, Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands.

Brower is himself a U.S. Navy veteran, having served as a surface warfare officer on active duty and in the Naval Reserve. He recently joined Snell & Wilmer as a partner after serving for almost two years as Nevada's U.S. Attorney.
